DARLEY HAY TOP TEN

To be contested in the form of a knock-out team competition and played on neutral greens. Each team to consist of 1 Single, 1 Pair, 1 Triple and 1 Four (1 optional trial, 2 in final) and full team must play. Single to play 21 shots, Pairs, Triples and Fours <u>15</u> ends, with 2 points awarded for each event won and 1 point for a drawn match. If total points are tied, the match shall be decided on total shots scored. If both points and shots are equal, the winner of the singles shall determine the winner.

In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless <u>all</u> the following stages have been reached:

Singles: Any player to have reached <u>14</u> shots, Pairs, Triples and Fours: <u>10</u> ends to have been played. If the game is stopped and all the above criteria have not been reached, the match will be continued before the next scheduled round with scores standing at the point when the game was stopped, and substitutes permitted.

If the host club cannot stage the re-scheduled game, teams will toss a coin and the winner will host the match. Allocation of Final venue to be rotated equally among member clubs and, if that is abandoned, the President and Secretary will give the final decision as to when, and where, the final will be re-scheduled.

McLEAN BOWL

To be contested as a Triples competition, open to both Gents and Ladies, and played on one evening. All matches will consist of <u>3 Triples</u> to be played over <u>15</u> ends (1 optional trial) with 2 points for each winning triple and 1 point for a drawn match. In the event of tied points, overall shot difference will determine the winner. If points and shots are both tied, the honours will be shared.

Any match forfeited will result in awarding opponents 2 points and 7 shots.

In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless each triple has completed <u>10</u> ends.

CHARLES SMITH TROPHY

To be contested in the form of a League team competition, with rinks and venues to be drawn.

Each team to consist of: 1 Pair, 1 Triple, 1 Three Bowl Pair with the last week 1 Triple and 1 Four (7 players). All matches will be played over <u>15</u> ends (1 optional trial) with 2 points awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw. Any match forfeited will result in awarding opponents 2 points and 7 shots.

In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless <u>10</u> ends have been completed.

If play is stopped and the above criteria not reached, both sides will be awarded 1 point for each match.

WESTWATER CUP

To be contested in the form of a knock-out team competition and played on neutral greens. Each team to consist of 4 pairs playing <u>15</u> ends (1 optional trial, 2 in final) and full team must play. Winner to be the team which scores the greater number of shots, but, if the total shots are equal, all pairs shall be required to play extra ends until a result is achieved. All players must be available for the extra ends.

WESTWATER CUP (Continued)

In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless all pairs have completed <u>10</u> ends.

If the game is stopped and the above criteria has not been reached, the match will be continued before the next scheduled round with scores standing at the point when the game was stopped, and substitutes permitted.

If the host club cannot stage the re-scheduled game, teams will toss a coin and the winner will host the match. Allocation of Final venue to be rotated equally among member clubs and, if that is abandoned, the President and Secretary will give the final decision as to when, and where, the final will be re-scheduled.

McDONALD AGNEW SALVER

To be contested in the form of a knock-out singles competition with each club to select 2 players (method of selection to be decided at club level). No substitutes shall be allowed.

The competition shall be staged in August / September and, when the draw takes place, players from the same club cannot meet in their first game.

In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless any player has reached <u>14</u> shots.

If the game is stopped and the above criteria has not been reached, the match will be continued before the next scheduled round with scores standing at the point when the game was stopped.

If the host club cannot stage the re-scheduled game, players will toss to determine who will host the match. Final to be played on the President's green and, if that is abandoned, the President and Secretary will give the final decision as to when, and where, the final will be re-scheduled.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS CUP

To be contested in the form of a knock-out singles competition, open only to the current Champions of the Ayr Trophies Clubs. No substitutes shall be allowed.

The competition shall be staged in August / September to allow clubs to play off their Club Championships. In the event of a game being stopped for any reason (weather, green, etc), no result can be declared unless any player has reached <u>14</u> shots.

If the game is stopped and the above criteria has not been reached, the match will be continued before the next scheduled round with scores standing at the point when the game was stopped.

Final to be played on the President's green and, if that is abandoned, the President and Secretary will give the final decision as to when, and where, the final will be re-scheduled.

JAMES AGNEW TROPHY

The competition will be decided on points for all competitions, excluding the McDonald Agnew Silver Salver. Darley Hay Top Ten: Winner = 10 points, Runner-Up = 7 points, Semi-Finalists = 5 points McLean Bowl: Winner = 10 points, Runner-Up = 7 points, 3rd Place = 6 points, 4th Place = 4 points Charles Smith Trophy: Winner = 10 points, Runner-Up = 7 points, 3rd Place = 6 points, 4th Place = 4 points Westwater Cup: Winner = 10 points, Runner-Up = 7 points, Semi-Finalists = 5 points Champion of Champions: Winner = 10 points, Runner-Up = 7 points, Semi-Finalists = 5 points In the event of a tie, the trophy will be shared for that year.

ALL COMPETITIONS

In all competitions, players and teams will be permitted **20 minutes** after the stated commencement time.

ENGRAVING OF TROPHIES

It shall be the responsibility of the clubs which have won each trophy to ensure that the year and club's name (players names in the Champion of Champions and McDonald Agnew) be engraved on the trophy before the following season.

TOP 5 COMPETITION

At the recent Ayr Trophies AGM, it was proposed to stage a Top 5 Singles Competition.

In 2023, Maybole Memorial Park represented Ayrshire in the Scottish Top 5 under the 'banner' of the Carrick League, as the Ayrshire Bowling Association do not currently have an equivalent competition.

Furthermore, we are also aware that the Kilmarnock Bowling Association are giving the matter consideration, so there are numerous possibilities moving forward.

The format is 5 Singles matches over 21 shots with one team winning either 5-0, 4-1 or 3-2.

The first named team would be at home (similar to Ayrshire Top Ten) and, if all 12 Ayr Trophies clubs were to enter, we anticipate an entire month be allowed for all matches to be arranged by competing clubs as follows: Round 1 – Play by end of May Round 2 – Play by end of June Semi-Final – Play by end of July

Final – To be played in August/early September
