Club Competitions for 2026

All competition information and dates relating to team matches, selection and club representation for various events will be posted on the relevant notice boards, along with the formats, entry sheets and rules for internal club competitions. The committee would like to wish all members a happy and successful bowling season.

Bar Opening Times (Summer)

The bar will be open during competition days and subject to demand.

Club members may also apply to use the bar and club facilities for private functions. Such events will require committee approval.

*Please note that bar hours across the season will be regularly reviewed. Hence, the hours are subject to change depending on demand throughout the season and specific events that may take place across the year.

During the year, there are various forms of entertainment organised within the club such as quizzes, bingo and cabarets.

All club entertainment and private events will be communicated to members via the notice boards around the clubhouse, Facebook page and via the website at www.prestwick.bowls-club.co.uk

Other Information for Members

All members should fully acquaint themselves with Constitution, Code of Conduct and Bye-Laws of the club. Copies are located at the Club entrance to the club and at the back of the 'members details booklet' located adjacent to the bar area. Copies can also be attained by email request to the Secretary.

The club has a range of membership options available to suit individuals and families and are detailed in the Club Constitution.

Organising Ties

Once competition draws are complete, it is recommended that you take note of your opponent's name, contact number and the date the competition must be played by.

Contact is recommended to be made as early as possible, to avoid a congestion of members having too many ties to be played with little time to do it. This is especially important at the beginning of the season, as most members are in multiple competitions. If members don't contact their opposition early enough and leave ties to the last few days before the date for the tie is up, this results in ties not being able to be played and both players/teams being eliminated from the competition.

To arrange a tie, we recommend you contact your opponent via text message or WhatsApp and give your opponent options of dates you could play. You could also contact your opponent via a phone call, but by using a messaging platform this allows all information to be in writing, and should there be any dispute about ties, the Match Secretaries will be able to see all communications regarding the tie between players.

We would recommend in team competitions (pairs, triples and fours) that one member from the team sets up a WhatsApp group with all players involved in the tie, then between all players they can sort out a date that is suitable.

If any member is planning to go on holiday during the season, it is their responsibility to get in touch with all their opponents and play the ties before the holiday. Failure to do this will result in them being eliminated from competitions or a substitute will need to be found in team games.

If you need any help with organising your ties, you can contact the Match Secretaries within the club, and they will do their best to help.
